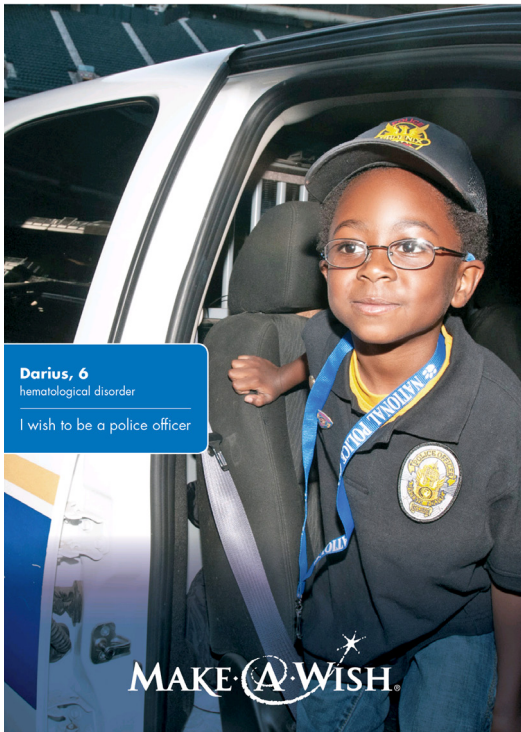

On average, the Animal Protective League Spay/Neuter Clinic performs 52 surgeries per day, which translates to approximately 1,100 surgeries per month, more than 13,000 surgeries per year, and over 100,000 since it opened in 2006. As a regional facility, APL partners with more than 30 animal control agencies, shelters, and rescue groups within a 90-mile radius to offer low-cost services to those shelters and their area's citizens. Fatuma works in the labor ward at Musoma Hospital in Musoma, Tanzania, where she's on a team of 20 nurses that delivers 10 to 13 babies a day. Before AmeriCares program began, staff would ask patients to bring gloves and other safety gear when they arrived at the hospital because shelves were often empty. Without protection and safety procedures, diseases such as HIV and hepatitis B and C can easily spread in a labor ward – from patient to health worker or health worker to patient. "I cry for personal protective equipment," says Fatuma. "It is essential."

For four years, AmeriCares has been improving health worker safety in Tanzania. After AmeriCares pilot safety program at Bugando Medical Centre in Mwanza proved successful, the program expanded to three more hospitals. Fatuma is one of 1,750 health workers and students now taking part. AmeriCares will vaccinate staff against hepatitis B and supply the hospital with gloves, waste bins and other equipment as well as training proven to create a culture of safety.

120,000 miles of rivers and streams in Illinois provide essential drinking water, industrial water, habitat, agricultural water, and flood control to our communities.

EarthShare Illinois members work to protect these resources and see that they are as healthy and clean as needed to support all of their uses.

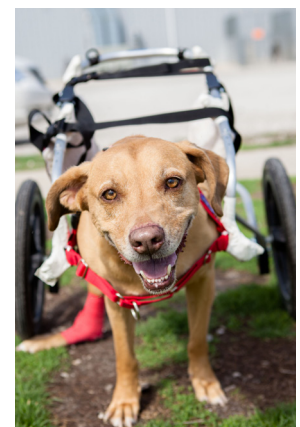
